

**INFO FINANCIAL HELP COVID-19**  
**CANADA EMERGENCY RESPONSE BENEFIT (CERB)**

The **Canada Revenue Agency** will provide a **taxable** benefit of **\$2000** per month for **4 months** to workers who have been impacted by **Covid-19**.

ELIGIBILITY	WHEN	HOW
Employee, self-employed or contract worker	It will be possible to <b>register</b> during the week of <b>April 6<sup>th</sup></b> , if your <b>CRA</b> account has been created	Via <a href="#">CRA My account</a> or <a href="#">My Service Canada Account</a>
15 years old and over and have made at least <b>\$5,000</b> in 2019 or in the last 12 months.	The first <b>cheques</b> will be sent within <b>10 business days</b> of your request. Or by <b>direct deposit</b> within <b>3 business days</b> of your request	By phone: <b>1-800-959-2019</b>
Lost income due to <b>COVID-19</b> for at least 14 consecutive days	You will receive a <b>cheque</b> every <b>4 weeks</b> and will be offered from March 15, 2020 to October 3, 2020.	Both of these services are available 21 hours a day, <b>7 days a week</b> . Both services are <b>closed from 3:00 a.m. to 6:00 a.m.</b> for maintenance.
Losing your income because you have <a href="#">COVID-19</a> and you are in <b>quarantine</b> .	You will need to apply and confirm your eligibility <b>every 4 weeks</b> if your situation continues	<b>EMPLOYMENT INSURANCE</b>
Losing income because you have to <b>stay with the children</b> or have to <b>take care</b> of someone with <a href="#">COVID-19</a>	You will <b>stop</b> receiving this cheque after <b>four months</b> , or sooner, if you <b>get your job back</b> .	If you are <b>already receiving</b> Employment Insurance, you will have to <b>wait</b> until your <b>benefits cease</b> (Same applies to individuals on parental leave (QPIP))
Have <b>no other</b> sources of income	<b>CANADA CHILD BENEFIT</b>	If you <b>already applied</b> for Employment Insurance and your application has not yet been processed would <b>not need to reapply</b>
Have not quit your job <b>voluntarily</b>	The <a href="#">Canada Child Benefit</a> will provide an extra <b>\$300</b> per child in <b>May</b> .

**Note:** These benefits are taxable and you will need to report any payments received on next year's tax filing. An information slip will be made available for the 2020 tax year in My Account under Tax Information Slips (T4 and more).
